FOR METAL FANS, IT'S GOING TO BE A "HOT METAL SUMMER"

NASHVILLE, Tenn.--A unique promotion which demonstrates the growing acceptance of Christian "heavy metal" begins this week as a cooperative effort between The Benson Company, Frontline Records and Enigma Records. Dubbed "Hot Metal Summer," the promotion features a "collector's" cassette which features songs and interviews with Enigma artists Stryper and Barren Cross, and Frontline artists Bloodgood and Shout. The cassette retails for \$2.99 and will be displayed in a special fixture designed for the promotion. Participating retailers will also give a free 2' X 3' poster to customers. Hot Metal Summer, which begins this week with the release of Stryper's *In God We Trust* and Bloodgood's *Rock in a Hard Place*, is being promoted with print ads in key Christian publications.

The promotion was the creation of Kent Songer, Frontline's director of marketing and promotions. "It seemed to be the logical thing to do," said Songer. "A common distributor--Benson--has the two most popular Christian [metal] bands in Stryper and Bloodgood, as well as two great up-and-comers like Shout and Barren Cross."

Vince Wilcox, Benson's vice-president of marketing, coordinated the task of forging cooperation between two separate record companies. "Vince did a great job with a sensitive situation," commented Songer. "The real beauty of this is that it is a Christian bookstore-only promotion. The Christian marketplace will be the only outlet where fans can get the cassette or poster."

COMPANY MERGERS RESHAPE CANADIAN DISTRIBUTION

TORONTO, Canada--Three Canadian distributors have joined forces in an effort to improve operating and cost efficiencies for both wholesaler and retailer. The move involves the merger of Creative Music Canada with Mainroads Productions and the subsequent decision by Mainroads to have its order entry, warehousing and accounts receivable handled by Beacon/Scripture Press, itself the result of a merger earlier this year.

John McIntosh of Creative Music Canada (CMC), which handles Star Song and Refuge product in Canada, began talking with Steve Nicolle of Mainroads Music in early 1988 and by March the two companies announced the formation of Mainroads Marketing Group. Shortly after that, Mainroads announced the deal with Beacon/Scripture Press of Whitby, Ont. Van Hisey, sales administrator for

B/SP, stated: "This arrangement should be advantageous, since it embellishes the 'one source' concept."

Indeed, in a country where 'one source' independent distributors such as Spring Arbor don't exist, Hisey's statement rings true. However, Spring Arbor itself is making serious inroads into the Canadian market. This, combined with the looming 'free trade' pact between Canada and the U.S., gives impetus to the efforts of Canadian companies to better service their clients.

One advantage of the new arrangement between these companies is B/SP's membership in the Canadian Telebook Agency, a computerized inventory analysis system which gives Christian and secular retailers access to a wider range of books, videos and music products.

"The result is what we believe to be a most exciting and perhaps trendsetting new way of doing business," says Mainroads' Nicolle. "Once stores see this system in place, we are convinced they will see the tremendous benefits offered by this new concept."

CREATION FESTIVAL CELEBRATES 10TH ANNIVERSARY THIS WEEK

MT. UNION, Penn.--It's the tenth anniversary of Creation--not as recorded in Genesis, but as conducted each year here in western Pennsylvania. Creation '88, to be held June 23-25 at the Agape Camp Farm, is the tenth edition of what is now billed as "the world's largest Christian festival."

With the theme "A Call to Integrity," Creation '88 will offer Christian music and teaching which organizers hope will address the problems of spiritual and personal integrity. The event features an appearance by Amy Grant and Gary Chapman as well as Petra, Mylon & Broken Heart, Twila Paris, BeBe & CeCe Winans, David Meece, Carman, Margaret Becker, Whitecross and others. Speakers include Tony Campolo, Josh McDowell and Denny Duron.

As many as 40,000 are expected to attend the event, which uses 600 volunteer staff members, over a million dollars worth of sound equipment, 250,000 watts of lighting and a 25-foot projection video screen. The Agape Camp Farm offers 500 acres of usable land with camping space for 30,000.

The festival is sponsored by two non-profit ministries--Come Alive of Medford, NJ and Creative Ministries of Lancaster, PA. Co-directors are Harry Thomas of Come Alive and Tim Landis of Creative Ministries.

A WORD FROM AN UNKNOWN

If I let myself, I could get really frustrated. I have been writing and singing my own songs for 10 years and have been issuing them out to publishers, producers and record companies for about half of that time. Unfortunately, all I have to show for my efforts is a pile of rejection letters. Actually, there is *one* quasi-acceptance letter--Word Records did express a mild interest in a song I wrote called "Count On Me," but I never heard anything further from them.

I'm sure I'm not the only songwriter who has experienced this. I am equally sure that I am not the only one with an overwhelming desire to be recognized as a singer and/or songwriter with talent enough to be successful in the business. Being my own worst critic, I often become frustrated when I receive a rejection notice from a company for what I think is my best work. When I think of the time, money and effort spent just to send it, I get even more discouraged... especially knowing that my desire to see the public exposed to my message and talent goes unsatisfied.

As often as I can, I sing my songs to my church of 50 people. Sure, the congregation seems to enjoy my music, but I'm not sure if the applause I receive is genuine. I'm uncertain whether they clap because they are honestly blessed by what they heard or because they feel obligated. Whatever the case, my frustration returns. I had to ask myself why I wasn't successfully excelling; why I hadn't landed a publishing or recording contract. I felt like a failure.

Then, to my surprise, I began receiving requests from fellow church members for specific songs. And when I would sing them, people would approach me after the service, smiling gratefully. "Thank you for singing that song, Kevin. It really ministered to me." As they would proceed to offer details of how it ministered to them with a sincerity that humbled me greatly as I recognized God's working through my music.

Before long, various people were asking me if I had a tape of my songs. "I'd really like to be able to listen to you at home," people would say.

As more and more tapes were requested, I went to bed many nights with my songs playing over and over

in my head from hearing them so many times as I filled cassette orders. Silently, I griped about having to sit in front of my makeshift recording contraption after shelling out my own money to buy blank cassettes so that I could transfer my songs for someone else's use. As I crawled into bed one night it dawned on me that this was exactly what I had been praying for! A chance to reach a wider public with my songs, spreading the good news of Jesus Christ to those who want and need to hear it.

The difference is that I'm not receiving royalties and I'm doing all the work myself. But then I remember Paul's letter to the Corinthians where he says, "I will gladly spend and be spent for you." (12:15). This is what ministry is all about! Until this time, my idea of success was to be "professional," to get published, recorded and paid. But now, whenever I get a request to sing a certain song, whenever someone comes to me pushing a blank tape to be filled, whenever a parent informs me that his or her children have been singing my songs, and whenever I gaze into eyes filled with blessed tears because the lyrics to one of my songs touched a life, I realize how shortsighted I can be. Jesus Himself never wrote a book and never had a

hit record, yet no one has had the universal influence He has had.

Recently, a young mother and her children approached me at church and began singing one of my songs. After they finished, I remained in my pew, smiling at having been serenaded. I felt successful as I remembered that God has the ability to multiply the fruits of our labor—even when we cannot always see it at first.

Sure, I'd still like to become a published songwriter and record a studio album. But if and when I do, it will be in God's perfect timing. Perhaps one day a manila envelope—dispatched long ago—will reappear in my mailbox, perfectly flat. I'll open it and remove the letter: Dr. Mr. Kraft, we are pleased to inform you that after reviewing the material sent to us....

But until that time, I'll just keep doing what I'm doing!

\$12 MILLION FIRE GUTS WHME STUDIOS

SOUTH BEND, Ind.--Afternoon announcer Don Houk was playing Chuck Swindoll's "Insight for Living" program on Sunday, June 12 when he noticed smoke in the hallway. Shortly afterward, listeners to WHME-FM and viewers of WHME-TV heard and saw nothing as a fire gutted most of the facility. No one was injured.

The television station, one of eight owned by LeSea Broadcasting, was preparing to begin a telethon. The fire may have begun in the phone bank area, which had been worked on extensively prior to the blaze. The television and radio studios were completely destroyed. Damage was estimated at \$12 million.

WHME-FM, which lost its transmitter as well, received a new Harris unit last Thursday and expected to resume broadcasting on Friday (17). Temporary studios have been set up eight miles away at the Christian Center, which operates the stations. The new transmitter will be housed in a truck trailer adjacent to the tower (which survived the blaze) until a new facility is built. Construction is expected to take five months.

The television station was able to go back on the air six hours after the fire by utilizing a two-camera remote setup at the church.

Program director Craig Wallin says that record companies have been helping the station restore its music library and that nearby competitor WFRN has graciously provided access to its library. Still, Wallin says that additional record service is needed. Contact WHME, 61300 Ironwood, South Bend, IN 46614.

PICK OF THE WEEK:

Amy Grant, *Lead Me On* (Myrrh/A&M)

This highly anticipated release should mend fences, bring vitality again to Christian music, and leap tall buildings in a single bound. Pardon us for being overly optimistic, but this is one of the best Christian albums ever. Grant and her production entourage (David Anderle of A&M, Mike Blanton, Gary Chapman, Executive Producers: Brown Bannister, Producer) avoided the fun, pop-y arrangements of *Unguarded* for a classier, more sophisticated acoustic sound. Grant delivers her best vocal performance yet—realizing the potential exhibited on her interim project since *Unguarded*. The lyrics, however, are the high point. Shunning the temptation to include trite, sanitized Christianese, Grant and team chose songs that are intensely personal, flavored with spiritual depth and Biblical integrity. The seemingly unachievable goal of pleasing Christians without offending non-Christians has apparently been done with *Lead Me On*. "Wait for the Healing" and "If You Have To Go Away" are on the CD only.

The Awakening, *Into Thy Hands* (Reunion Records)

This Canadian band's second release is a big step forward from their first. This is a cohesive, mature presentation from a group with a pronounced direction. Their aggressive and progressive rock stylings are definitely influenced by Rush. Their lyrics feature a creative blend of fascinating imagery and straight ahead spirituality. AOR shows and college-age customers should love this.

Dino, *Hits of the 80's* (Benson)

An alternative title for this release could have been *Dino Plays the Songs Sandi Patti Made Famous*. This collection of fully orchestrated arrangements—Dino style—contains "How Majestic is Your Name," "O Magnify the Lord," "Via Dolorosa," and more. Whether the average Christian inspirational consumer will accept these contemporary hymns as "hits" remains to be seen.

Israel's Hope, *Arise O Lord* (Fortress)

This five-year-old trio from Maryland present a very enjoyable and accessible collection of Jewish praise and worship songs. The album contains simple arrangements, nice harmonies, traditional instrumentation, and straightforward praise songs. Background vocals by First Call. The current movement of Jewish dance and music in Charismatic churches should help this album's popularity.

Rich Mullins, *Wind of Heavens...Stuff of Earth* (Reunion)

Mullins third album features his trademark light, breezy pop-music (though much fuller). The songs however, highlight a welcome global perspective, reflective of a missionary trip he took to the Far East last year. The acoustic-based arrangements (with percussion from the Miami Sound Machine's Rafael Padilla) are very enjoyable and should appeal to a broad range of tastes and ages.

Rosanna's Raiders, *Calling Down the Fire* (Pure Metal)

This Australian band brings their Heart-like hard rock on this first U.S. release. Rosanna Palmer proves herself an effective rock vocalist. Production is adequate but a bit thin overall for this style. The lyrics take a decidedly positive approach. Palmer and her husband, the band's guitarist, are Assembly of God pastors at an inner-city church in Melbourne.

Phillip Sandifer, *Constant* (Urgent)

Sandifer's fourth album returns him to the ranks of the independent. This release, from his own record company, will not be distributed by Sparrow. The music is polished, top 40 pop with fine vocals and deeper lyrics than most. A solid member of the pop vocalist field.

Spin 180, *Time to Burn Bridges* (Harbinger/Benson)

Deemed "rock 'n roll missionaries to America's universities," Spin is the brainchild of veteran artist, Craig Smith. The production is rock-solid, heavily influenced by the late 70's pop-rock bands. Smith proves to be a strong rock vocalist and arranger.

Margaret Becker, "Light in the Darkness" (Sparrow) CD
Rock debut from *The Reckoning*, helps to shed Becker's Heart-like mantle and establish her singular style. Driving guitar orientation surrounds a powerful message of effectual Faith.

Geoff Moore & the Distance, "Go to the Moon" (Sparrow)
Wisecracking mid-western rock supports an examination of Christianity's tendency towards separatism and escapism. A slamming beat, catchy guitar leads and the frolicking ambience of the cut makes for rockin' fun. 12"

Stryper, "Always There For You" (Enigma)
Stryper debuts *In God We Trust* with this celebratory cut. Lots of driven pop-metal squeal and sizzle.

Kim Boyce, "Not For Me," b/w "Save Me" (Myrrh) 12"
The sugary pop "Not For Me" coyly covers the problem of being "unequally yoked" as a weaving bass supports synth shimmer. Flip side's sassy culture track uses a dance groove to speak on the incongruity of materialism and total surrender to Christ.

Steven Curtis Chapman, "Faithful Too" (Sparrow) CD
Chapman blows it out on this debut rocker from *Real Life Conversations*. Opening guitar hook sets an energetic, upbeat tempo as the artist proffers consistent personal faithfulness.

Tom DeVor, "Jesus In My Heart" (Milk & Honey)
Simple acoustic guitar tune backs a storyline on the earthly life of Jesus with a personal confession of Faith. Appealing for its honesty and simplicity.

Phil Driscoll, "I Can Feel Your Love," (Benson) CD
Uplifting cut of spiritual renewal musically features cascading keys, up-front percussion and a bass solo by Abraham Laboriel.

Tonio K., "Stay," b/w "Executioner's Song" (What?) 12"
"Stay" is a honest emotional plea for love and forgiveness. Stellar soundtrack *should* make this one a hit, but the music's artistic integrity will unfortunately relegate to adventurous AC's and hotter. B-side's churning "Executioner's Song" speaks of the darker side of "the garden," as Charlie Sexton harmonizes on the chorus.

Andrea Marcee, "This Love We Share" (Parable)
This noteworthy independent release provides a fine introduction to newcomer Marcee and her vocal talents. Throbbing bass and active percussion capture the artist's upbeat energy. 615/292-9973

Tim Miner, "Hey You!" (Sparrow) CD
Except for a mid-song rap attack on some selected pet sins, "Hey You" is an all out modern rocker with its big beat, power guitar and layered synth bank. Lyrically points to taking responsibility for one's actions.

Hope Sterling, "Never Let Us Go," b/w "You'll Not Leave Me" (Image 7)
Featured cuts from Hope Sterling's debut Image 7 release, *The Way Things Are*. Both cuts speak of the steadfast nature of God and feature airy vocals and unique modern stylings. "Never Let Us Go" takes a gentle approach, while the flip's "You'll Not Leave Me" shows a quirky flair.

Terry Talbot, "Battle Hymn" (Live Oak) 12"

Highest debut is from Frontline's new rock outfit Shout, which premieres at #17. Just missing a top 20 debut is Take 6 at #21 and Don Francisco at #23. Watch for Steve Green to make a strong debut next month and, of course, Amy Grant the month after that. Word Distribution has 26 of the top 50, followed by 12 for Sparrow/Star Song, 10 for Benson and one each for Spectra and Brentwood.

Adult Contemporary

Anyone who wonders whether Amy Grant is "back" or not need only check out the AC chart this week. After debuting last time at #15, "Saved by Love" rockets to the top. It's Amy's first #1 AC song since "Sing Your Praise to the Lord" hit #1 in July 1982. "Find A Way" from 1985's *Unguarded* peaked at #2 as did "Stay for Awhile" from *The Collection* in 1986.

Inspirational

Gorden Jensen goes to #1 in his second week on this chart with "When I Lift Him Up In Praise," which is his first #1 song. He narrowly edged out 2nd Chapter's "Take It To All the World," which moved up 10 to #2 after debuting last time. John Michael Talbot and Buddy Greene appear to have peaked, frustrated in their bids for #1. Michael Card has the highest debut with

"That's What Faith Must Be" from his *Present Reality* album.

Contemporary Hits

Amy Grant bypasses all the rest, going straight to the top with "Saved by Love." Mylon's "Won by One" and Mark Farner's "Isn't It Amazing" are locked into second place in a virtual tie. Meanwhile, other debuts include Carman, Renee Garcia, David and the Giants, Jon Gibson and First Call. Singing in Swahili must mean crossover, because "O Sifuni Mungu" (say that 10 times fast!) currently appears on the AC, Inspirational and CHR charts this time.

Rock

Mylon maintains a respectable lead on the rock shows as "Won by One" remains at #1 for the third consecutive reporting period. Rick Cua is hanging in there with a very solid #2, but whether he can go all the way with this one remains to be seen. Greg X Volz makes a top 10 debut with "Come Out Fighting" from his new LP, while Mark Farner, Stryper, Geoff Moore, Flock 14 and Randy Stonehill each enter with new songs.

Video Sales

Michael W. Smith's *Big Picture Tour* takes over the top spot from Sandi Patti, with Kenny Marks' single-song video of "The Party's Over" as the runner-up. Like the Top Albums chart, the Video Sales chart represents an interesting blend of inspirational and rock.
