SPARROW BOOSTS NEW ARTISTS WITH MAJOR SUMMER CAMPAIGN

CHATSWORTH, Calif.—In an effort to build upon the successful introduction of three new artists last year, Sparrow has targeted more than two million households in an intensive national campaign supporting the new product from these artists. Sparrow's so-called "New Music Summer" centers on new releases from Margaret Becker (*The Reckoning*), Steven Curtis Chapman (*Real Life Conversations*), and the Sparrow debut of Tim Miner (*I Know You Think You Know*). Also included is last year's BeBe & CeCe Winans album (new product from the duo is expected in the fall).

The new albums, along with a five-song "New Music Summer" compact disc and cassette, are scheduled to ship to retail beginning this week. The promotional mini-LP, which lists at \$5.99 on CD and 99 cents on cassette, contains one song from each of the four albums plus a bonus track from Geoff Moore and The Distance. The cassette is free if the consumer purchases an LP, cassette or CD of Becker's, Miner's or Chapman's new album. In addition to retail, it will be used in conjunction with concerts, festivals and in churches.

A 25-minute "New Music Summer Video" featuring Becker, Miner and Chapman discussing their music and ministries is being sent to Christian media and selected retailers. The promotion is supported by bookstore posters, mobiles and divider cards and special incentives are being offered to retailers.

Radio has been serviced with a New Music Summer 12" single containing the first singles from the new albums plus BeBe & CeCe Winans latest single. It was also serviced on CD. In addition, a one-hour radio special featuring the four artists is available to stations.

SANDI PATTI HOME VIDEO CONTEST OFFERS \$5,000 GRAND PRIZE

NEW YORK, NY—On the eve of her sold-out concert at Radio City Music Hall May 14, Sandi Patti announced the launching of the "Sandi Patti Home Video Contest." Sponsored by Word, Inc. and The Helvering Agency, the contest culminates in October with the awarding of a \$5,000 Grand Prize.

Categorized into five divisions (youth group, college/undergraduate, graduate school, amateur, and international), entrants are to develop a music video that "corresponds and enhances the concept, message and ideas as found on the recording, 'In

Heaven's Eyes.'" The song is from Patti's current top-selling album, *Make His Praise Glorious*, and is her new radio single. All entries must use Patti's recording of the song.

Cash prizes will be awarded to the top three winners of each division with the \$5,000 Grand Prize and a Sony television going to the top two overall winners respectively. The winning entrants will be announced and shown on a special edition of *The 700 Club* on CBN in October. Entry deadline is September 30.

According to Word's Dan Johnson, the contest was developed as a "tangible means of expressing Sandi's and our interest in young people and to encourage them in skills and training to further prepare them for a meaningful and creative life of service to Christ.

"Secondly, as a communications industry, Word, Inc. and The Helvering Agency agree on the need to stimulate Christian young people (and those on the edges of youth groups) in the creative, artistic avenues of video production (conceptual, technical, theatrical, writing and editing) by giving them an opportunity to exercise their skills in this new and developing medium."

"I believe that some of the most imaginative kids today are Christians," says Patti. "But, gospel music today is more than just musicians. It's an industry of professionals, now including those in video, film and television. I want to encourage this new breed of young Christian professionals to actively pursue a music/video/film ministry, and I hope this contest will help open some doors of opportunities."

CCM PUBLICATIONS EXPANDS TO NASHVILLE NEXT MONTH

LAGUNA HILLS, Calif.—CCM Publications, Inc., publishers of CCM magazine and *The CCM Update*, will open a Nashville office next month according to company Chairman Christopher C. Dewey. (The magazine's editorial and advertising offices have been located exclusively in Southern California for the past 10 years.) "Nashville is a major center of influence in the Christian music industry," said Dewey, "and it is important that the industry's most influential publication has representation there."

To emphasize the company's belief in the importance of Nashville, CCM editor John W. Styll will relocate there with his family. Assisting him with editorial responsibilities will be his wife, Linda. CCM Publications' other full-time staff will remain at the main office in Laguna Hills, south of Los Angeles. The Nashville office will open July 5.

One theory is that retailers have exhausted their buying budgets in order to stock up on Amy Grant, Steve Green and other big new releases...

* Speaking of big new releases, Sparrow reportedly "pre-pubbed" 230,000 units of the new Steve Green album, *Find Us Faithful*. Pre-orders on Green's previous album, which was discounted on the front-end, totaled 193,000...

Pearman, 36, was the driver of the church bus which exploded in flames after being hit head-on by a truck driving on the wrong side of the road. "BEST OF ALL TIME" LIST: IT'S TIME TO FACE PREJUDICES

I was both heartened and disappointed by the "Top 25 of All-Time" list in the last issue of *CCM*. I'm encouraged to realize that many of what would be my selections were included on the list. I'll never forget the first time I put the needle down on *With Footnotes*, *White Horse*, or *For Him Who Has Ears to Hear*. You knew that you were hearing something that was far and away better than what had come before.

My disillusionment came as I looked at the list in its entirety and saw the obvious bias of our little clique called 'contemporary Christian music.' Not one black artist made the list. If I was just talking equal opportunity it would be one thing. But to so obviously exclude works by artists such as Andrae Crouch, Edwin Hawkins, and the Winans—just to mention some obvious choices—is to ignore the powerful legacy and debt that contemporary Christian music owes to black artists and to the black church in general.

If we desire to assess the cause of stagnation in our industry, this list is a good place to start. If this is the

best we have to offer the world, then no wonder we've yet to make a lasting impact on society.

I'm aware that many of the boundaries have been imposed by others and at times we are forced to work within them. However, at some point we need the integrity and courage to break through the artificial lines that seem to keep things neat... and comfortable.

Speaking from a purely business standpoint, I can assure you that the same malaise that now hangs over contemporary Christian music does not cloud the skies of Christian black music. Groups like Commissioned, The New Jersey Mass Choir, the Winans (any of them), Kingdom, and others are paving new paths and producing music that begs comparison with any secular counterpart.

The time has come to honestly face our prejudices and break down the artificial barriers. If we start with the music, maybe the church will not be too far behind.

NEW RETAILERS' GROUP FORMED

NASHVILLE, Tenn.—Several Christian music retailers met during Gospel Music '88 and decided to form the 'Christian Music Retailers Group' (CMRG). The organization hopes to affiliate with the Gospel Music Association, which has formed similar alliances with radio stations (National Christian Radio Association) and concert promoters (National Christian Promoters Roundtable).

The steering committee for the new group consists of George Williams of His Excellence Bookstore in Nashville, Lee Stepleton of Sunshine Book & Gifts in Baton Rouge, Jim Willems of Maranatha Village in Santa Ana, Calif. and Linda Zuch of Omega Music Distributors in Pisgah Forest, NC.

The CMRG steering committee will meet next month during the Christian Booksellers Association convention in Dallas and again during Gospel Music '89 in Nashville. "This is an exciting adventure which started with the vision of Jim Willems over three years ago," said Stepleton, who

also noted that Christian music retailers are invited to "actively participate" with the CMRG.

FIRST-EVER 'HEAVY METAL DUMP' HITS

ALLENTOWN, Penn.—Pure Metal Records has released what it is calling "the first-ever heavy metal dump bin" for use in Christian book and record stores. According to Pure Metal head Gavin Morkel, "this is the first time a Christian record company has created a multi-title retail display bin for heavy metal music, and we're really excited about the initial response to the project. Never before has anyone tried a metal marketing campaign of this magnitude in retail outlets."

The three-sided, coal-black "dump" holds up to six different titles in the LP, cassette and CD formats. Pure Metal has shipped four new titles, with two more scheduled for the coming weeks. Current releases include *Live to*

Die by Bride, *Too Late For Living* by Saint, *Calling Down Fire* by Rosanna's Raiders and *Heavy Righteous Metal*, a compilation album. New releases are expected from Whitecross and Force 3.

Specials for retailers include giveaways and a "free music guarantee" on the Tim Miner album. A similar guarantee was used last year to introduce Becker and Chapman.

The New Music Summer artists will be featured on the cover of *CCM* in July and in Sparrow's *Premiere* magazine. A press packet containing group and individual photos of the artists plus the artist's press kits will be sent to newspapers, magazines and other print media.

Leaving no stone unturned, Sparrow is also sending a "New Music Summer Resource Pack" to 400 key youth leaders nationwide. Each packet includes the promotional cassette, the video, copies of *Premiere* for their groups, and Bible studies to accompany the music.

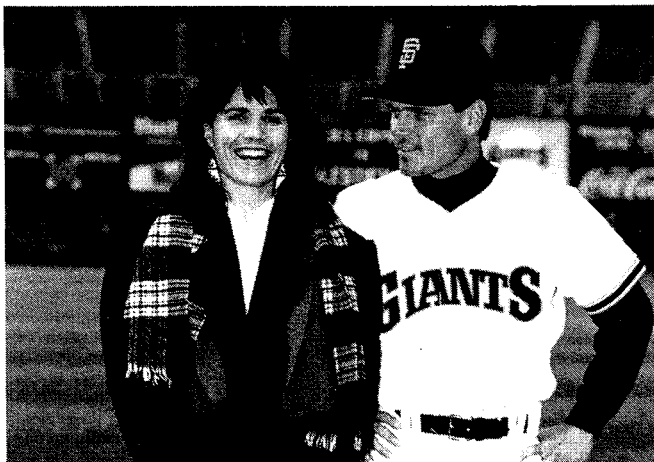

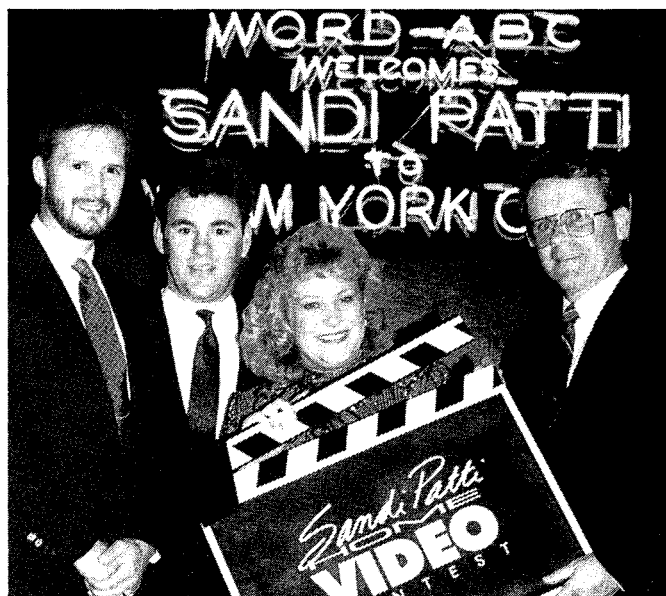

PICKS OF THE WEEK:

Michael Card, *Present Reality* (Sparrow)

Christian music's premier theology teacher takes this from his trilogy on the life of Christ to *Present Reality* which is based on the writings of Paul. This release marks a change from the serious and academic to a brighter, jazzy feel—but still packed full of meaty doctrinal teaching. The arrangements are simple and classy. The lighter feel could further expand Card's audience. A brilliant album.

Stryper, *In God We Trust* (Enigma/Benson)

There's not much heavy in this metal but the kings of holy head-banging kick out another collection of slick pop-metal. This album capitalizes on their strengths: accessible songs, tight rock harmonies and simple arrangements. Their position in the mainstream of the glam metal scene will either strengthen or advance with this release. Retailers take note: Stryper's previous release, *To Hell With the Devil*, went platinum.

Bill Baumgart, *The Kindling* (Frontline)

Baumgart switches hats from Frontline's primary producer to a Frontline recording artist. His pleasant pop vocals are accompanied by driving pop music with a rock edge. Mellow rock ballads accented by classy Keaggy guitar work are a natural for AC radio. It features a duet with Crystal Lewis on "Turn Your Heart Around," which was also on Lewis' album.

Margaret Becker, *The Reckoning* (Sparrow)

Becker's second album is unusually strong for a young artist. She solidifies her identity by advancing beyond the slick Heart-like rock of her first album to a more sophisticated rock sound accented by creative guitar touches. Her passionate vocals add credibility to some very personal, almost confessional lyrics. The first single, "Find Me," is a killer (see "Picks of the Week.")

Jeff and Sheri Easter, *Home Folks* (RiverSong)

This young married couple draw upon their rich family musical heritages to create an effective blend of bluegrass and traditional country on their second album. It includes down-home themes, steel guitar, fiddle, mandolin, a great vocal mix and a very unoffensive twang. For serious country music fans.

Don Francisco, *High Praise* (StarSong)

High Praise brings this veteran artist full circle in a personal journey of praise and worship. This release features production, songs, music and most instrumentation by Francisco. The songs are simple praise choruses and touching songs of prayer, from upbeat to soft, destined to find their way into many church services.

Power Praise (Fortress)

This unnamed rock band primarily features the throaty alto vocal of Rosanna Palmer on praise songs—standards and originals—set to hard-rock arrangements. Unfortunately this foray into praise rock is underproduced.

Craig Smith, *Worship* (Benson)

Smith's fourth solo album (his debut with Benson) will draw obvious comparisons to John Michael Talbot. However, Smith has chosen a much simpler, scaled-down approach to worship music. His music is soft AC built around simple melodies with some classical touches. Smith is joined by Twila Paris and Talbot on several songs.

PICKS OF THE WEEK:

Margaret Becker, "Find Me" (Sparrow) CD

Becker previews her forthcoming project *The Reckoning* with this introspective cut on the rekindling of one's passionate faith. Plodding beat and guitar rhythm pair up with moody synths and Becker's distinctive vocal for a first-rate sophomore debut.

Steven Curtis Chapman, "His Eyes" (Sparrow) CD

Debut release from Chapman's new *Real Life Conversations* tells of the comfort involved in knowing that the Lord's gaze never leaves you. Acoustic backing of guitar, mandolin and strings enhance the cut's personal approach.

Steve Green, "Find Us Faithful" (Sparrow) CD

This title debut from Green's *Find Us Faithful* should become an inspirational classic. Lyrically encourages a faithfulness that can be passed down from generation to generation as full orchestration makes for a stately accompaniment.

Tim Miner, "Did I Forget to Say" (Sparrow) CD

The imminent release of *I Know You Think You Know*, and this debut single offering, complete the re-manifestation of Tim Miner. "Did I Forget to Say" is a gently passionate number of thanksgiving musically anchored by piano and brushed percussion.

Sandi Patti, "Love Will Be Our Home" (Sparrow) 12"

Another chart stormer for Patti. A light and uplifting opening melody crescendoes to full orchestration amidst a sprinkling of acoustic piano and guitar. First Call assists on vocals which emphasize bonding love.

Geoff Moore and the Distance, "One of Us" (Sparrow) CD

An often soft-spoken Moore discusses the implications of the Incarnation on this follow up to the near chart-topping "Heart & Soul." Mood setting modern keys and percussion make-up the lightly driven instrumentation.

Keith Green, "Go to the Hungry Ones," b/w "Walk and Talk" (Sparrow)

Third single from the *Ministry Years* project includes another never-before released cut from the late Keith Green. "Go to the Hungry Ones" mixes up keyboards and a weaving electric guitar in its no-nonsense message of compassion to the spiritually destitute. The flip-side's "Bonus Track" is a shuffling jam featuring a soulful choir, inspired organ accompaniment and a duet with Barry McGuire.

Leon Patillo, "Strong Tower," b/w "Melody of Praise" (Sparrow)

The spiritual refuge of Proverbs 18:10 is offered up in "Strong Tower," featuring Patillo's trade-mark electric rhythms and a pattering bass. B-side is no rock cut, but a down-paced worship tune offering praise and spoken scripture.

Prism, "He's Got the Whole World in His Hands," b/w "Seek Ye First" (Reunion)

These guys found a formula, and they ain't lettin' go. Classic church tunes spruced up with studio flash. B-side's "Seek Ye First" will have the Minneapolis Prince looking over his shoulder.

Tyrone Lacy & Amy Roth, "Peace Be Still" (Regency)

Stirring but tempered orchestration sets a fitting back drop for this powerfully moving duet. Roth and Lacy give fine performances as they testify to Christ's power over the storm. Highly recommended inspirational cut. (805) 581-9902

BeBe and CeCe Winans, "Change Your Nature" (Sparrow) CD

This fourth single from the Winans' self-titled debut falls a bit short of previous outstanding releases. Synth-dominated production veils the duo's superior abilities.

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CHART WATCH

Adult Contemporary

After just one period in the #1 spot, "Faithful," the first single from Reunion newcomer Kim Hill gets knocked off by Mylon & Broken Heart's "Again and Again." It should be noted, however, that the last time a debut single from a new artist reached #1 was a year ago April when Kim Boyce's "Here" went to the top. (Maybe some other new female artists should change their names to "Kim" if they want hits!) Amy Grant makes a very impressive debut with "Saved by Love," which lands at #15 after being in the market for only one week of the reporting period. Needless to say, it's a slam-dunk for #1. Michael Card's "That's What Faith Must Be" comes in at #21. Steve Camp continues to show remarkable strength with the third single (the title track) from *After God's Own Heart*, which moves up 5 to #3.

Inspirational

Sandi Patti maintains her lead, but by an ever-decreasing margin. The top three remain the same with John Michael Talbot and Buddy Greene hanging in there in a rather tight race. Larry Bryant make a 12-point jump with "Sometimes I'm Samson" and Kim Hill moves from #25 to #15 in her second appearance on this chart. Billy Crockett makes a six-point leap into the top 10, landing at #5. Gordon Jensen makes a top 10 debut with "When I Lift Him Up in Praise" and 2nd Chapter of Acts lands at #12 with "Take It To All the World." The other debut is Steve Archer's "Part of the Heart."

Contemporary Hits

Russ Taff's "Believe in Love" holds a tight grip on the top spot for the third consecutive period. Five of last period's new entries are making progress to the top though. Mylon & Broken's "Won by One" is making the most serious attempt, notching a #2 after its second period, but Mark Farner's "Isn't It Amazing" scores most significant forward progress honors, moving up 10 positions to #5 after its second showing. New Frontline act, Shout, has the highest new entry with their pop-metal ballad "Find A Way" --other new entries include the Allies' "It's Never Easy," and 2nd Chapter of Acts' new one "Take It to All the World." Gary Chapman's slow burner "Your Love Stays with Me" falls after a brief appearance.

Rock

Mylon & Broken Heart sustain a modest margin of victory with "Won by One," as "Can't Stand Too Tall" by Rick Cua makes a one position advance to the #2 position. Mad at the World shows consistency as the title cut from their latest, *Flowers in the Rain*, has remained in the top-10 since early April --last year's "Living Dead" showed the same long-standing appeal, remaining in the top-10 for a full three months. A host of singles show outstanding forward progress including the latest from Shout, The Choir, Undercover and Level Heads. Debuts include Bash's "You Are the One," David & the Giants' "Restless," and Broken Records places another new entry --Adam Again's "Trouble with Lies."
