## **BENSON/MARANATHA! MUSIC ANNOUNCE LONG-TERM PACT**

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.**--The Benson Company and Maranatha! Music have announced a long-term agreement between the two companies, whereby Benson will provide manufacturing, marketing, sales and distribution for Maranatha!'s complete line of recorded and printed product.

The agreement, effective January 1, 1990, will allow Maranatha! to function principally as an "artist," focusing its energies and resources into the research and development of its products. In turn, Benson will increase its depth in praise & worship and children's product, two areas Benson had targeted for growth for some time.

The announcement was made at Benson's winter sales conference, where Maranatha! conducted an extensive orientation to equip sales staff to begin selling product January 3rd.

"This is a significant change for Maranatha! that will enable us to expand our ministry in the '90s," declared Tom Coomes, president of Maranatha! Music. "The Benson Company shares our vision and heart and has the desire to help us bring people of all ages to a greater intimacy with God through praise and worship."

When asked what prompted the new relationship, Coomes told *CCM*, "After almost 20 years of ministry, we have really come to the conclusion that our calling is to be the creative part, to create products that can draw people closer to the Lord. We've tried to function in some other roles, and can see now where our best strengths lie. Benson has brought to us a new enthusiasm for our ministry that seems to really fit well into their vision for the future."

Jerry Park, general manager and chief operating officer of The Benson Company, agreed, stating, "The fit couldn't be any better. Benson has experienced a very successful year and to finish it by forming this partnership is a wonderful blessing. Having watched the folks at Maranatha! Music build such a strong ministry for the past two decades, we are convinced that we share a common vision for ministry through music. We can't wait to begin this new leg of the journey together."

Maranatha! Music was incorporated in 1971, with its first national distribution from an independent company called Living Waters in 1972. In 1978, the company signed a distribution deal with Word, Inc. which remains effective through the end of the year. Maranatha!'s first entries into the praise/worship and

children's music markets still sell well to this day, and both *The Praise Album* and *Kids Praise I* have sold over 500,000 units.

The addition of Maranatha! Music significantly expands Benson's product line, and the company stands to increase business by a third, according to Park. Benson will add A&R, marketing, and field/phone sales staff to support the additional product.

## **GMA WEEK "SPECTACULARS" TO FEATURE 18 TOP ARTISTS**

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.**--The Gospel Music Association has announced the lineups for its annual multi-artist "spectaculars," to be held during Gospel Music '90 next April at the Tennessee Performing Arts Center. On Sunday, April 1, the program will be hosted by Shirley Caesar, who will perform along with the Ralph Carmichael Orchestra, Commissioned, Mom & Pop Winans, the Williams Brothers, the Christ Church Choir, Nicholas, and DeLeon. The evening will be produced by Gloria Hawkins.

Monday's lineup features host/performer Sheila Walsh, First Call, Steven Curtis Chapman, the Imperials and Steve Camp, in a program produced by Don Boyer. Tuesday's host/performer will be Michael W. Smith, and the evening will also feature performances from Charlie Peacock, Allies, Kim Hill and Renee Garcia, and will be produced by Melinda Scruggs. All three concerts will begin at 7 p.m.

Gospel Music '90 will also include the meetings of the National Christian Radio Seminar, Church Music '90, the National Christian Promoter's Roundtable and the Christian Music Retailers Guild. Special industry seminars and roundtables, new artist showcases, a songwriters showcase and several receptions are also a part of the week. This year, the 21st Annual Dove Awards will be telecast live on The Nashville Network on April 5.

It began November 26 with the telethon benefitting the Juvenile Diabetes Foundation, syndicated on the USA Cable Network, then on to TNN's *Crook & Chase* Nov. 28, CBN's *700 Club* Dec. 8, and a taping of Lou Rawls' *Parade of Stars* telethon, benefitting the United Negro College Fund, which will air in syndication Dec. 30 in 80 markets. Airing tonight (18) on NBC is the network's annual *Christmas in Washington* program, where Smith performs "Gloria" with the Eastern High School Choir in front of an audience that includes President and Mrs. George Bush, who invited Smitty and the other performers back to the White House for an informal carol sing around a piano played by U-No-Who. ## PICKS OF THE WEEK:

**Sandi Patti, *The Finest Moments*** (Word)

This 14 song "best of" collection presents the songs that have become Patti's trademark. The selections were culled from eight previous albums, plus one new song, "Exalt the Name," written by Margaret Becker and Mark Hauth. Perfect for holiday gifts.

**Michael Card, *The Beginning*** (Sparrow)

*The Beginning* marks the beginning of Card's new trilogy called *The Ancient Faith*. This release is based on the Pentateuch (the first five books of the Bible) and the patriarchs. The production builds on the sound of his first trilogy—orchestral adult contemporary music with occasional touches of country and jazz.

**Petra Praise, *The Rock Cries Out*** (DaySpring)

This is Petra's twelfth release and perhaps the closest one to their hearts. In their travels, they noticed the lack of praise music produced with rock-generation teens in mind. This album contains mostly familiar choruses and some new ones, set to a rock format with occasional metal and blues stylings. The project has been designed with youth groups in mind, with a companion music book and accompaniment tracks on cassette and CD. Don't overlook general consumer appeal, though, Petra fans should eat this one up.

**One, *Spirit to Spirit*** (Word)

The debut collection from this trio highlights their great blend set to light pop reminiscent of the Imperials in the Taff and Smith days. One's style shouldn't be too spicy for old timers, or too traditional for boomers.

**Rick Crawford, *Rick Crawford*** (Live Oak)

Although this is Crawford's debut, he is no newcomer to the industry, playing in Dallas Holm's band for six years, opening for Wayne Watson for two, and writing songs for Watson, Morgan Cryar, Marty McCall, and others. The album was produced by labelmate Matthew Ward and features Crawford's catchy, meaty tunes set to upbeat pop/rock music. Run this by fans of Ward, Watson and Greg X. Volz.

**Rez, *Innocent Blood*** (Grr/Ocean)

Rez's tenth release reminds us that these guys were heavy before they called it heavy metal. Their guitar-driven hard rock majors on the blues (a good place to be in light of Whitesnake and Bonham's popularity). Includes a great remake of The Who's "Bargain."

**Billy Crockett, *The Basic Stuff*** (Urgent)

Crockett's debut on Urgent marks only his third release overall. Despite the similarities to Rich Mullins, his super-fluid, smooth style, jazzy pop/folk, and upbeat attitude makes him instantly likeable. There should be a good amount of interest in Crockett in light of his opening stint on Sandi Patti's '89 tour.

**Kenny Marks, *Another Friday Night*** (DaySpring)

Marks' fifth album is clearly his best. He's sounding more confident in his style of All-American pop/rock. The melodies are simple, heavy on hooks, and instantly singable, but the production and vocals have improved dramatically. His songs should speak to today's teens. Great for fans of Mike Stand and David Mullen.

**D-Boy, *Plantin' A Seed*** (Frontline)

D-Boy Rodriguez's debut is the classiest Christian rap yet, due in part to the funky influence of co-producers Tim Miner and White Heart's Tommy Sims. The tunes are pure pop-hop, best suited lyrically for Christian youth, although the Boy proves he can get streetwise and gritty when he wants to.

## PICKS OF THE WEEK:

**Russ Taff, "I Cry" w/ "Winds of Change"** (Myrrh) CD  
Second ballad from *The Way Home* features sensitive lyric and an early sixties country/pop string arrangement reminiscent of Roy Orbison and Patsy Cline. A different sound for Christian AC/inspirational that could be a real bright spot in the format. "Winds of Change" is an exciting, infectious tune that will work for CHR, light rock and harder AC's.

**Farrell & Farrell, "Heart of the Homeless"** (DaySpring) CD  
Latest single from the Farrell's *Superpower* album is a powerful paean to the plight of the homeless, done with lyrical and musical taste. The arrangement is sparse, with acoustic guitar and percussive production touches, filled out with effective vocals.

**Paul Smith, "Beat of a Different Heart"** (DaySpring) CD  
Smith continues to define and expand his own style with this latest tune, loaded with memorable moments and hit potential. Good add for any solid AC or CHR station.

## Noteworthy

**Benny Hester, "Before You Know It"** (Frontline) CD  
Another heavy hitter from Hester, with a typically catchy chorus and a vocal that gets a little raw at the end, but probably not too edgy for most AC's at the end of the '80's, right?

**Crystal Lewis, "God Is Somebody"** (Frontline) CD

A wonderful, classy ballad worthy of mainstream airplay, from the little lady with the big voice. Maybe too urban-sounding for some AC's, but it sure seems to work for Whitney in secular AC....

**Vector, "I Want to Know" w/ "Where Are You Now?"** (Alternative) CD

Fans of 80's Christian rock at it's most progressive will remember Vector, who made some fine albums like *Mannequin Virtue* and *Please Stand By*. The good news is that there is some new music, available on Rob Woolsey's latest independent compilation, well worth hearing and playing. "I Want to Know" is great for Christian rock formats, and the other tune is mellow enough for most AC's, but probably just too "different."

**Leon Patillo, "Rock House" w/ "More of You"** (Ocean) CD  
Though Patillo seems a bit out of touch with current urban/R&B trends, "Rock House" does sport an infectious energy that may endear the ears of CHR MD's. The ballad is predictable Patillo, pleasant but overly repetitious.

**Witness, "Without You in My Life"** (Lecton/Polygram) 12"  
Remember the crossover success The Clark Sisters had a few years ago with "You Brought The Sunshine?" This tune sports the same approach and dance/pop groove, which may spark the interest of more pop oriented radio. Witness is a modern gospel "girl group" whose career may prove to be well worth watching.

**Jacob's Trouble, "Waiting for the Son"** (Frontline) CD  
Interesting combination of modern pop/rock elements make for a winner here. Sounds like Ireland, Atlanta and Nashville rolled into one, with a U2-ish intro kicking off an acoustic jangle-pop track fronted by a second generation contemporary Christian vocal. It works, though, and will brighten up any Christian rock format.

**David Baroni, "Morningsong"** (LifeStream) CD

It takes a while to get going, but this is a really tasty light pop tune that could cross the bridge between modern inspirational and light AC formats well. Though the arrangement is typically late 70's, the production values are up-to-date, and the praise oriented lyric should land it well on Christian radio.

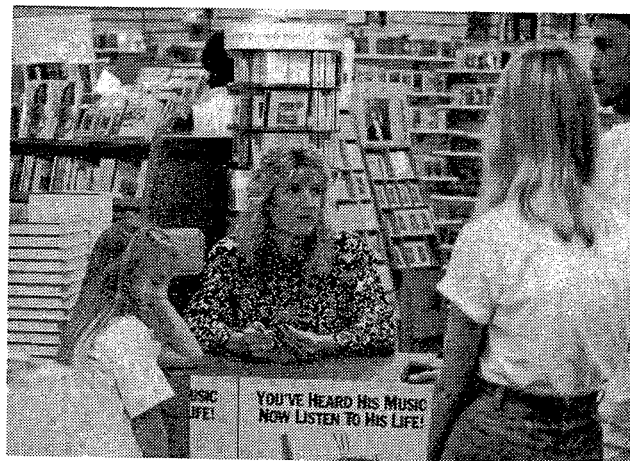

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## CHART WATCH

### Adult Contemporary

In a rather surprising move that it is becoming nearly status quo for this artist, Kim Hill's "Charm is Deceitful" jumps from #9 to the top of the AC chart this week, followed closely by Steve Green's "The Mission." Bob Bennett's "Lord of the Past" takes a 12 position jump into the top ten, not to be outdone by Sandi Patti, who rockets up and down the chart simultaneously, with "Masterpiece" dropping 21 slots to #35, while "Exalt the Name" fires up 19 notches with a bullet, as they say. The first single off David Meece's latest album, *Learning to Trust*, "The Man with the Nail Scars in His Hand," is the chart's highest entry this week at #14.

### Contemporary Hits

In the space of just two chart reporting periods, Mylon LeFevre's "Love Comes Down" comes up—debuting at #10 two weeks ago, and sitting proudly atop the CHR chart this week. Kim Hill's other mover, "Inside of You," pushes ahead to #3, with a batch of strong new music (fronted by Russ Taff's "I Cry") moving in to warm your winter ears better than your best set of muffs.

### Inspirational

Ray Boltz continues to provide a commanding presence on inspirational radio formats, with "The Altar" hanging tough at #1 for another reporting period, pursued closely (as on the AC chart) by Steve Green's "The Mission." Otherwise, the rest of the top ten is remarkably stable, even for this format.

### Rock

It's an omen for the 90's folks, when a song called "Driving in England" can be #1 on a Christian radio chart, and who better but the Swirling Eddies to do it? Petra's "I Love the Lord" jumps from #20 to #8, tying Sacred Warrior's arrangement of "Holy, Holy, Holy" for the week's biggest mover.

### Top Albums

After an already impressive #1 entry on the last album chart, Carman's *Revival in the Land* continues to outsell its closest competitor by an almost two-to-one factor. Equally impressive is the entry of Sandi Patti's greatest hits collection *The Finest Moments* at #3, and a massive 29 place jump for the *Petra Praise* album, giving them two albums in the top 10.
